

FRIENDS CREEK CONSERVATION AREA CAMPSITE RESERVATION PROCEDURE

Camping is available by reservation or on a first come first served basis.. Reservations may be made by calling the Macon County Conservation District at 423-7708, Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. A non-refundable reservation fee of \$5.00 and security deposit of the first night's camping fee, which is \$10.00 in-county residents, \$12.00 out-of-county residents for non-electric sites, and \$15.00 in-county residents, \$18.00 out-of-county residents for electric sites, will be required to secure the reservation. Payment may be made by credit card, check or cash.

The camping day begins at 3 PM. Maximum length of stay is 14 days.

Check out is 2 P.M

Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. All non-camping visitors must leave by 10 p.m.

Pets are welcome and must be on a secured leash Owners shall clean up after their pets.

Alcohol is not permitted.

Gathering firewood is strictly prohibited. Campers are asked not to bring firewood in from Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, or Illinois counties where infestations of the emerald ash borer are prevalent.
