

Policy on compliance with the Illinois Freedom of Information Act

The Board of Trustees recognizes the right of members of the public to have access to public records in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA” or the “ACT”), and affirms that it is the policy of the District to comply with the Act.

The Director shall designate one or more officials or employees of the District to serve as its Freedom of Information Officer(s), and shall develop and implement administrative procedures to effect compliance with the Act.

At each regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, the President or Director shall report any FOIA requests made of the District and the status of the District’s response.
